An eye-opening documentary that focuses on many never-before-seen solutions designed to slow down our escalating environmental crisis, *Ice on Fire* goes beyond the current climate change narrative and offers hope that we can actually stave off the worst effects of global warming. Narrated by producer and Oscar®-winner Leonardo DiCaprio and directed by Leila Conners, who first collaborated with DiCaprio eleven years ago on *The 11th Hour*, the feature-length documentary focuses on cutting-edge research behind today's climate science – and the innovations aimed at reducing carbon in the atmosphere, which could pave the way for a reduction in the global temperature rises and a benefit to the planet's life systems. With sweeping cinematography of a world worth saving, *Ice on Fire* crossing the globe, from Norway to Alaska, Iceland to Colorado, Switzerland to Costa Rica to Connecticut to highlight the firsthand accounts of people at the forefront of the climate crisis, with insights from scientists, farmers, innovators and others, finding that while the risks and urgency may be higher than ever today, there are also greater opportunities for innovative solutions, offering a realistic but hopeful perspective on a key global issue that demands our attention.

From Emmy®-winners Peter, George and Teddy Kunhardt (*King in the Wilderness*, *John McCain: For Whom the Bell Tolls*), this feature documentary follows Bryan Stevenson – lawyer and founder of the Equal Justice Initiative – through his experiences as a capital defense attorney and advocate for community-based reform. Interweaving watershed moments from Stevenson’s cases with insights from his clients, colleagues and members of his family, *True Justice: Bryan Stevenson’s Fight for Equality* focuses on Stevenson’s life and career – particularly his indictment of the U.S. criminal-justice system for its role in codifying modern systemic racism – and tracks the intertwined histories of slavery, lynching, segregation and mass incarceration. Offering intimate access to Stevenson as he reflects on the transformative moments in his career, the film chronicles his work in Alabama, the birthplace of the Civil Rights Movement and home to the Equal Justice Initiative, as well as the early influences that drove him to become an advocate for the poor and the incarcerated. Illuminating the power of memory in cultural change, *True Justice* instills hope of a brighter American future through the insights of this remarkable pioneer.

On April 26, 1986, the Chernobyl Nuclear Power Plant in the Soviet Union suffered a massive explosion that released radioactive material across Belarus, Russia and Ukraine, and as far as Scandinavia and western Europe. *Chernobyl* is a gripping five-part miniseries that tells the powerful and visceral story of the worst man-made accident in history, following the tragedy from the moment of the early-morning explosion through the chaos and loss of life in the ensuing days, weeks and months. Approaching the story from every angle, encompassing the perspectives of plant workers, firemen, doctors, scientists, residents and Soviet bureaucrats, the miniseries juxtaposes compelling human stories of bravery and sacrifice with the shocking inertia of a government intent on passing blame and downplaying the dangers of the disaster. Featuring an ensemble cast led by Jared Harris (Emmy® nominee for *Mad Men*), Stellan Skarsgård (*Melancholia*) and Emily Watson (Oscar® nominee for *Hilary and Jackie* and *Breaking the Waves*), *Chernobyl* is written by Craig Mazin (*The Huntsman: Winter's War*) and directed by Johan Renck (*Breaking Bad*).

Davies, whose impressive body of work includes *Queer as Folk*, *The Second Coming*, and the 2005 revival of *Doctor Who*.

When motorists become stranded, three towing companies are called on to pull them to safety: Borealis, Ron’s and Lucky 7. These three teams have worked through the worst that nature can throw at them, but with snowfall capable of topping 12 feet and temperatures that drop as low as 60 degrees below zero, every rescue attempt comes with a high-degree of risk.
